Music Scholars Program - 2024

Mission Statement

To inspire youth by providing them with the opportunity to perform music for a diverse audience, while enriching worship at St. Peter's and supporting our outreach efforts.

Program Description

- This program is financially supported by the Don and (late) Margaret Walter family.
- The program awards up to four scholarships per summer.
- Youth of any age may apply, up to and including students enrolled in a music program at university undergraduate level.
- Applicants need not be members of the St. Peter's parish, nor are they required to be cottagers in our community. If an applicant is not from our lake community, please see the note below about 'Logistics'.
- In return for selection as a Music Scholar, the youth participant agrees to perform during a church service in July or August. A stipend of \$150 will be paid for this performance.
- Participants will work closely with our Music Director regarding accompaniment and choice of music that is appropriate for a church service.
- A single bursary of \$500 will be awarded to one of the Music Scholars each summer. In return, this individual agrees to do a repeat performance in our church the following summer.
- The Selection Committee will select the bursary recipient, based on the quality of the church performance.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee is appointed by the Wardens and is presently made up of Blair Mackenzie, Bob Trennum and Tony Whittingham. The Coordinator of the Program is Bern Kelly, who serves in an 'ex-officio' capacity on the Selection Committee.

Logistics

St. Peter's on-the-Rock is located on an island. It is understood that boat transportation may be required if the Music Scholar is not a cottager on our lake. This can be arranged by the Program Coordinator, who can facilitate boat transportation to and from the island from either Kawartha Park Marina or Carveth's Marina.
